### **CAMPION SCHOOL PE CHANGING POLICY**

#### **Rationale:**

The below procedures are specifically designed to ensure all students access physical education. The uniform is designed to allow participation throughout the year considering the following: weather; health and safety; student voice; accessibility.

#### **Uniform:**

- Compulsory Green Campion School polo shirt
- Green Campion School rugby shirt
- Plain black shorts
- Plain black crew neck jumper
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms
- Black Campion School leggings with school logo/Black Sports Leggings
- Black Campion School zip-up jacket
- Campion Sports Socks

#### **Footwear:**

- Trainers suitable for indoor and outdoor (converse are not excepted)
- Football boots are recommended when lessons are on the field
- Gymnastics Rubber Grip Socks -

#### **Health and Safety Compulsory Items:**

- Shin pads
- Gumshield
- Hair-ties for all hair long enough to be tied up
- Tape to cover jewellery that cannot be removed
- Nails cannot protrude the length of the finger
- Change of socks after all lessons

#### **Weather Dependent:**

- Under tops/skins to be worn under PE uniform
- Plain Black Jumper
- Towel
- Wipes/cleaning products
- Roll on deodorant (aerosols are not permitted in school)
- Sun hats/sun cream
- Woolly hats and gloves

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No items which have a hood will be allowed to be worn in any PE lessons or after-school activities. No outdoor coats to be worn in any lessons. **Excused:**

Our mantra is: 'Sick or fit bring your kit.' All students will be expected to change and join in the lesson on some level. Students who are physically unable to participate in the practical aspect of the lesson must provide a parent/carer letter explaining the reason for their non-participation. The letter must be brought in by the student and given to their PE teacher. Students who are excused will be expected to take part in other aspects of the lesson where possible. This could include leading a warm-up, helping coach and improve students' performance, and umpiring or refereeing. It is essential that students remain part of the learning process and will be involved in all lessons regardless of their injury/illness. We do this to ensure students are able to continue to learn and develop throughout the lesson limiting any gaps in learning and ensuring they remain involved in the lesson as opposed to falling behind.

**No Kit:**

Forgetting kit is not an excuse for students to be excused from lessons. Kit will be provided for these students and they will be expected to participate. We have a strict one-use policy and all spare kit is washed after use. If students forget their kit on more than one occasion they will be issued with the following:

**1st kit mark** = Warning

**2nd kit mark** = C20

**3rd kit mark** = C60

**4th kit mark** = Meeting in school with parents and student.

If the problem continues the matter will be discussed with heads of year and senior management and, if necessary, parents will be invited into school to discuss and resolve the matter.

**Non-conformity:**

Students who do not bring PE kit and refuse to wear school kit will be dealt with in accordance with the school's behaviour policy. They will be expected to change and wear the school's PE uniform.

All lessons will aim to go ahead in their desired location so students will therefore be outside in cold and wet weather. It is essential students plan ahead for this.

Although we do have a policy, we wish to work with students to overcome all barriers to sport, please contact the PE team with any queries or issues.
